BOOKS

Norway:

Students use books for free. At the end of the year they have to give them back to the school

Italy:

Students who attend 1st-2nd grade can use books for free; they have to give them back to the school at the end of the year.

TRIPS

Norway:

Students usually don't have to pay. Sometimes they have to give a little contribution (in Lower Secondary

- Students can get about €90 per year to buy the equipment (pens, paper...)
